

Overview of the Latest Impact of Major Earthquake on Canon ANELVA Operations

We at Canon ANELVA Corporation extend our condolences to all those affected by this disaster and our thoughts go out to those suffering in its aftermath. In addition, we hope that the region will soon be able to begin the rebuilding and healing process.

The following is a summary overview of the latest impact of the earthquake on Canon ANELVA Corporation.

1. Damage (including damage following the earthquake in Shizuoka Prefecture on March 15)

- (1) No injuries to its employees and families have been reported.
- (2) There has been no major damage to the Headquarters and the Fuji Factory that may impact its operations.
- (3) Operations of the Tohoku Service Station and the Tsukuba Service Station, where damage was significant and are suffering from power outages, have been suspended. The Headquarters is substituting their operations.

2. Operations

- (1) Sales network and service stations in the western half of Japan are operating as usual.
- (2) Following the implementation of rolling blackout, operation of the Fuji Factory will be suspended Thursday, March 17. The Factory will be operated Monday, March 21 (national holiday) to compensate the suspension of operation.
- (3) Due to disruptions of roads and railway services, delays in delivery of goods and services are expected. The Company will continuously make every effort to minimize such delays.
- (4) The Company is implementing measures to conserve electricity by stopping or minimizing use of air-conditioners, elevators, lights, etc.
